SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT DAYS – TERM 2

School Development Days are negotiated student free days which are used for staff development and school planning. This year, we have two School Development Days in Term 2, being the first Monday, 29 April, and Friday 31 May, the Friday before the WA Day long weekend.

Monday, 29 April will see school staff involved in a range of Professional Learning, an update on Guided Reading and using whole school data collection to guide our planning. Additional time will be spent on school planning.

On Friday 1 June, staff will be involved in the Combined Ellenbrook Network School Development Day Conference. This annual event is attended by staff from local public Ellenbrook schools. Teaching Staff and Education Assistants have an opportunity to select a range of concurrent sessions throughout the day. An example of these includes; First Aid, Protective Behaviours, Adjusting the Curriculum, Data Analysis and Numeracy. Staff also have a valuable opportunity to network with staff from other schools.

TERM 2 PROBLEM SOLVING CHALLENGE

Next term, students in Pre-Primary to Year Six will be participating in a fortnightly problem solving challenge. Problem solving is an integral part of Mathematics and supports students to develop their understanding of mathematical vocabulary. All classes within the same year level will complete the same problem, which will be relevant to what is currently being taught in class.

When solving problems during mathematics, we use **RUCSAC**.

- **R** - Read the question carefully
- **U** - Understand the question
- **C** - Choose the correct method
- **S** - Solve the problem
- **A** - Answer the question
- **C** - Check your answer



Students in Year One to Year Two will receive a RUCSAC template each fortnight and students in Year Three to Six will receive their problem via Seesaw/Google Classroom. Pre-Primary students will complete problems by rehearsing strategies which have been introduced in class.
