NATIONAL ASSESSMENT PROGRAM – LITERACY & NUMERACY (NAPLAN)

A reminder that our students in Years Three and Five will take part in the NAPLAN in Week Three. Students will be tested in reading, writing, language conventions (spelling, grammar & punctuation) and numeracy, using common national tests.

The key purpose of the NAPLAN is to provide system, school, parents and caregivers with information about student performance in relation to nationally-agreed achievement bands. The achievement bands represent increasing levels of skills and understandings. For each vear group in each assessment, there is a national minimum standard that represents the minimum standard of literacy and numeracy skills considered necessary for students to progress through schooling.

Please contact classroom teachers if you would like more information on these tests.

Please ensure that students are at school on time and that classes are not disrupted during NAPLAN Testing.
