You need to apply to enrol your children in school for 2020 if they are:

- starting Kindergarten 4 years old by 30 June 2020
- starting Pre-primary, the first year of compulsory school 5 years old by 30 June 2020
- starting Year 7, the first year of secondary school
- changing schools.

The closing date for all Applications is Friday, 26 July 2019. Please note Applications for Enrolment are not to be confused with Enrolments. All applicants will be contacted shortly after closing date advising if their application has been successful and invite them to return and complete enrolment forms.
