Dear Parents/Carers,

It is with great excitement we announce the 2020, Year Six camp. Along with graduation it is the highlight of the students' final year of primary school. We have calculated the cost of the 2020 camp for our Year Six students. During Year Five, the students have managed to raise a staggering \$3165 by carrying out various fundraising events. The P&C, once again, have offered to donate \$1000 towards the cost of transportation. After deducting these along with the \$50 deposit already paid, the outstanding cost is **\$265** per child.

Where: Point Peron Camp, Point Peron Rd, Rockingham

When: Tuesday, 31 March to Friday, 3 April 2020

Times: Depart Aveley Primary School at 9:00am. Students need to be at school by 8:30am Tuesday morning. Arrive back at Aveley Primary School at around 2:30pm Friday afternoon.

Aim: To give the children the opportunity to experience outdoor education activities in a natural environment. To promote an appreciation of the environment, to foster teamwork, build self-confidence and to improve communication skills while meeting new challenges.

Activities the children will be participating in:

All activities will be led by experienced, qualified staff who will take responsibility for the technical aspects of each activity and the related safety of the children whilst on camp. All camp staff members will have a WA Working with Children Card, Education Department Standard Police Clearance and Senior First Aid Certificate.

Adult supervision on camp: Five teachers from school will be attending camp and we require three parent helpers to attend for the duration of the camp. Parents are encouraged to indicate their expression of interest to attend by ticking the box on the attached permission form. If the number of parents interested exceeds the required amount, we will randomly select by drawing names from a container and then notify all successful and non-successful parent helpers.

Food: All meals are provided throughout the camp except morning tea and lunch on Tuesday. Children are encouraged to bring a packet of biscuits/cake for supper. These will be collected and shared. Please indicate any allergies or dietary requirements on the form provided, so we can liaise with the camp chefs.

Payment: Full payment will be required by Friday, 13 March, 2020. A payment plan can be negotiated with the office, which would allow smaller payments to be made over the term, culminating in the final amount being paid by the due date.

Student Checklist:

(Please make sure all items are named)

- Sun safe hat (school hats can be used)

- 3-5 changes of clothing, including one pair of long pants and one outfit that can get very dirty
- 2 pairs of joggers (One that can get wet, enclosed shoes **MUST** be worn during water activities)

- Personal items such as soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, brush/comb
- Towel
- Rain coat
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow and pillow slip
- Sunscreen
- Drink bottle (reusable)
- Plastic bag for laundry

- A small back-pack
- Torch
- Insect repellent

What not to bring:

- **Any electrical device including mobile phones**
- Money – as there is no need
- Any extra food or lollies

Camp Duties: Children are expected to be responsible for keeping their dorms clean e.g. making beds, vacuuming and keeping them in a neat and tidy condition. Children will not be asked to clean toilets, but floors and basins are to be kept clean and free from rubbish. Working in small groups, the children will set up for each meal and wash up after.

Communication: A phone is available for emergency use at the camp office and teachers will carry mobile phones. We understand that for some children (and parents) this is their first independent trip away from home but, don't worry, we will take good care of them and contact you if we need to.

Vehicles: A safety vehicle will be on hand for medical emergencies.

Permission and Medical Form: Please find attached a permission and medical information form that needs to be completed and handed in through the front office. By signing the form, you are giving consent for your child to attend the camp and travel on the bus provided by the school. Any medication your child requires needs to be given to staff in a labelled snap lock bag with instructions clearly noted.

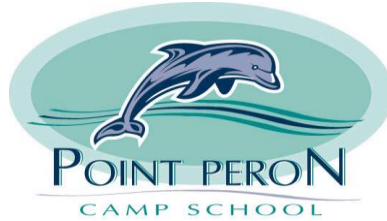
