Being Prepared & Tips (for Home)

Should your child be required to isolate, we ask that you prepare the following items at home to support their learning:

- Lead pencil, sharpener, eraser
- Coloured pencils or textas
- Glue, Ruler, Scissors
- A device and internet access if available.
- Find a suitable place to work
- Reduce distractions (E.g. turn TV off, games away...)
- Make your space comfortable
- Stick to a daily routine and schedule
- Make sure your device and/or headphones are ready

1. In class with relief teacher for those at school.

2. Year Level shared learning group to be made available.

3. Class Relief Teacher Information File available

Admin/Specialists to Support (at home)

Learning at Home:

1. Online delivery through Connect.

2. Work package avilable (families with no internet or device)

3. Daily email/phone call check in.

Attendance for child at home:

Monitor through Connect submissions / return of completed paper work to school

- ents isolating at home will be provided with learning from home ons. Students will need to access this content via Connect.
- ents isolating with no internet/device access will have a paper work age available from administration.
- Administration Team and/or Specialist Teacher (if required) will call ents isolating to check in and answer any questions.
